State higher educational institution “Kyiv national economic university named after Vadym Hetman” is asking you for advertising in scientific-analytical journal “Neuro-fuzzy modeling techniques in economics”. The journal is annual.

Terms of article submission

For publication of the article you must present:

1. Electronic copy of the article, drawn up according to the conditions stated below.

The articles should contain significant scientific results, which can be not only of theoretical (to contribute into development of theory and methodology of neural networks or fuzzy logic), but also of a practical character (to contain solution of a certain applied task with construction of economic and mathematical models, its program realization and experimental investigation of their efficiency). The results will be estimated according to their level of scientific and technical potential.

2. Application should be drawn up according to the following pattern:

“Neuro-fuzzy modeling techniques in economics”

Note. All this information is to be presented for every single author (apart from title of the article, which is to be presented once for the whole group of authors).

Files should be named with the surname of the first author in Latin (e.g. Savina.doc, Savina_application.doc).

**Requirements for scientific articles,
which are to be presented to the scientific-analytical journal
“Neuro-fuzzy modeling techniques in economics”**

Requirements for the structure of the article

1. Title of the article.

In the center of line in capital letters, type — bold.

The title of the article is to be presented in English, Ukrainian and Russian (translation).

In case of difficulties the Editorial will translate all corresponding elements of the article from English into Ukrainian and Russian.

2. The author of the article.

One line passed in the center, the initials and the author’s name is to be stated in cursive letters, type – bold. The information is to be presented English, Ukrainian and Russian (transliteration).

3. Information about authors.

From the new line in the center, scientific degree of the author should be stated without abbreviation. The new line — author’s position and place of work (in full, without abridgement and abbreviation). The new line — full work address with postal code and name of the country. All information should be presented in English, Ukrainian and Russian (full official translation of the name of organization is to be used). The new line — e-mail address.

If there are several authors of the article, the full information should be stated concerning each author according to paragraphs 2, 3 with one line passed between authors. No more than four authors are allowed.

4. Annotation.

One line passed. Annotation should be structured, laconic, informative and contain such aspects as: subject, purpose, method or methodology of research, results of research, sphere of results application, level of scientific novelty, conclusions. Volume 100-250 words. Annotation should be presented in English, Ukrainian and Russian.

5. Keywords.

No less than five, no more than ten words or combinations of words, in italics, in English, Ukrainian and Russian.

6. Code JEL classification for the article.

In the next line after Keywords, the amount can be from 1 to 5 codes, in one line, divided by comma, in bold. For example:

JEL Classification: C12, H12.

7. Text of the article.

One line passed. In the structure of the article the following should be stated:

— introduction (in which the following should be highlighted: stating the problem and its connection with important scientific or practical targets; the latest research and publication analysis with compulsory references on sources used; unresolved earlier parts of common problem, to which the article is dedicated);

— formulation of purpose and targets of research;

— explication of main part of research with full argumentation of received scientific results;

— conclusions and perspectives of further researches in this area;

— list of references.

The list of references is to be presented under the title “References” and should contain no less than 8 sources given in accordance with [international bibliographic standard APA-2010](#). If article is written not in English, its bibliographic description must be transliterated in Latin letters. In this case, the titles of periodicals are to be submitted transliteration, and in brackets – in English translation. For example: *Finansy Ukrainy (Finance of Ukraine)*. At the end of each entry should note the language of the original: [in Ukrainian], [in Russian], etc.

At the end of the article there should be a mark, that the article is presented for publication only in the journal “Neuro-fuzzy modeling techniques in economics”.

Technical requirements for the article

1. Requirements for the text:

— use a word processor MS Word 2003 or higher;

— text files are to be presented in MS Word with extension “doc”;

— paper size — A4;

— font — Times New Roman Cyr;

— size of type — 14;

— line spacing — 1,5;

— page numbering — bottom right of the page;

— page margins — 2 cm; from edge of paper to running title — 1,25 cm;

— first line indent of paragraph — 1,25 cm;

- do not make hyphenation;
- set up hanging lines ban in paragraph;
- article must be from 15 to 50 pages in length;
- titles of sections in the text of article — in the center in bold type, titles of subsections — in the center in italics;
- numeration of pages, points, schemes, tables, formulas are to be presented in Arabic numerals without symbol №;
- while typing do not use additional space bar for text formatting;
- do not set the first line indent of paragraph with TAB or space bar (set formatting only through paragraph parameters);
- inverted commas should be typed the same way through the whole article;
- do not use hyphen instead of dash.

2. Requirements for illustrations:

- quality of illustration should ensure its clear reproduction;
- schemes and graphs in the article should be implemented by graphic redactor of MS Word, or in one of the formats jpeg, bmp or tif with resolution not less than 300 dpi (originals of a high-quality);
- all objects in schemes, implemented in MS Word, should be grouped. Text of the article should not contain schemes or/and text in scheme frames, placed over or behind the text;
- schemes are to be signed and numbered (if more than one);
- title should be under the illustration and marked with shortened “Fig.” (Figure);
- schemes are to be placed after their first mentioning in the text;
- illustrations should not go on margin;
- since the printing is black and white, do not use background and color in graphs and diagrams etc.

3. Requirements for tables:

- before each table the word “Table” should be stated, with its ordinal number in the article and righthand side leveling;
- the next line should contain the title of the table in italics with the leveling in the center, according to which the table itself should be placed;
- text of the table can be smaller than the main text.

4. Requirements for formulas:

- formulas are to be composed with assistance program MS Equation 3.0 (formula editor in MS Word);

- formulas are to be leveled in the center;
- formulas should be numbered in brackets in the righthand side of the page with through numbering.

5. References:

- while referring in the text to the literary source an ordinal number in square brackets should be stated, which certain work has in the list of references;
- list of used literary source is typed at the end of the article, according to the order they are mentioned;
- all stated sources in the list should have references in the text of the article;
- all citations in the text or mentioning of the results received by other authors should be accompanied with certain references.

6. Notes:

- notes concerning the text are to be placed in the bottom of the text page which requires explanations;
- notes to the text should be done automatically and are numbered one after another in Arabic numerals;
- notes to the tables and figures, in which background and explanatory information is given, can be numbered one after another on one page;
- if there are several notes to tables or figures on one page, then after word “Notes” there is a colon, e.g.:

Notes:

1. ...
2. ...

If there is only one note, it is not numbered and after word “Note” there is a dot.

In addition:

- all the articles are to be reviewed;
- in the text of the article some editorial corrections can be brought during editor processing and proofreading;
- the authors of the articles are responsible for correctness and accuracy of the stated terms, data, facts, citations, statistic materials etc., and also for stating information in the articles which is not the object of open publication;
- only one article of one author can be published in one issue.
